

DEVIL FISH CITY


Dive Site:

- Famous for its Manta Rays, generally between January and April
- > 3 cleaning stations
- Best during slack high tide or incoming tide

Marine Life:

- Channel sides lined with massive fields of sea whips, sea fans, soft corals, and large stands of evergreen Tubastrea corals.
- Highlights are cleaning stations where Manta rays hover while cleaner wrasse and Butterfly fish rid them of parasitic isopods living in and around their mouth, gills and belly
- Coral heads are adorned with hundreds of copper sweeper baitfish
- Rainbow Runners, Reef sharks, Bumphead Parrotfish, black Snapper, black-bar Barracudas, Unicorn fish, striped Skipjacks, Fusiliers, Crocodile fish, Nudibranchs, Leafy Scorpionfish
