



LIGHTHOUSE CHANNEL & BUOY 6 WRECK

Dive Site:

- > The wreck, a small fishing vessel, used in WWII as a Sub chaser, is resting upright near Channel marker 6
- From 1941 onward, some 200 auxiliary submarine chasers of this class were built
- Currents can be extremely strong, but one can find shelter on the leeward side of the wreck
- Best to dive at slack high tide

Marine Life:

- The wreck is overgrown with hard and soft corals and home to many tropical fish
- A variety of Nudibranchs can be found on the wreck
- In the shallow upper reef areas, a variety of soft & hard coral can be found on both slopes, including massive Gorgonian fans
- Clusters of green Tubastrea corals decorate the sandy bottom around the wreck
- A variety of Angel fish, Lion fish, Crocodile fish, Cuttlefish, Anemones, lots of silver & blue Chromis
